(s , ss , sh , ch , x , z)

- watch watches
- marsh marshes
- box boxes
- dress dresses
- bus buses
- buzz buzzes



**** We can drop (y) and add (ies) that if the noun ends with (y) preceeded by a consonant:**

- | | |

| - lady | ladies |
| - baby | babies |
| - try | tries |



**** Don't drop the (y) if it is Not preceeded by a consonant :**

| - Play | plays |
| - toy | toys |

**** Change (f) into (ves):**

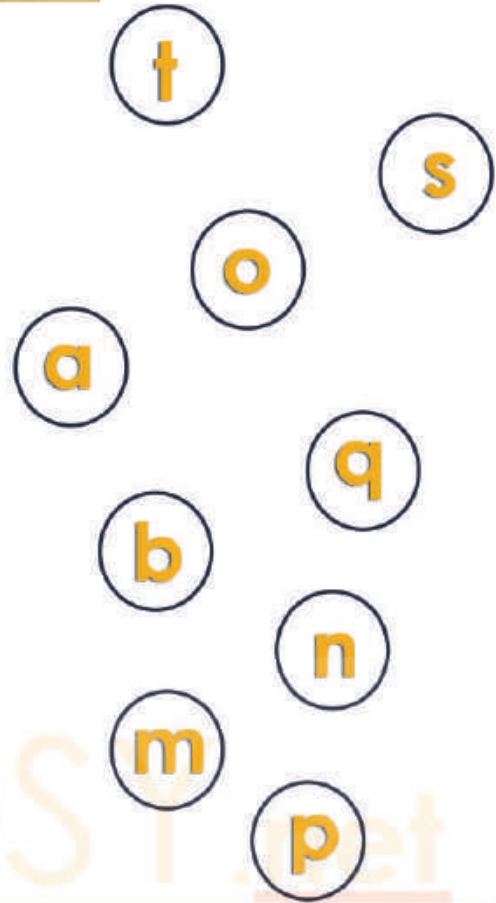
